Karetao | Making a puppet

Poi | Making poi

Taputapu: He wūru (he pai ngā tae rerekē), he pēke kirihou, he rawa ngāwari, he kutikuti, he hāpiapia .

Tohuwāhi | Making a bookmark

Taputapu: He pepa māro, he pene whītau, he kutikuti.
